

ROBERT H. ATTMORE was appointed to serve as the chairman of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board effective July 1, 2004, and he was reappointed to serve a second five year term starting July 1, 2009. Prior to joining the GASB, Mr. Attmore worked for New York State for more than 23 years, including serving as deputy state comptroller and state auditor from 1986 until 2003. Mr. Attmore has served as president of the National State Auditors Association and as a trustee of the Academy for Government Accountability. He is a member of the Board of Advisors for the Rutgers Business School's Masters in Governmental Accounting Program, and has served as a member of the U.S. Comptroller General's Advisory Council on Governmental Auditing Standards. He has also served in leadership positions in various other professional associations.
