Cornelia Chebinou has been the Director of the Washington office of the National Association of Auditors, Comptrollers and Treasurers (NASACT) since August of 1999. NASACT is a national organization that represents the states' views on a variety of financial management topics and is involved in research designed to provide the information necessary for improved financial management at the state level. NASACT's membership consists of the principal financial officers in each state with the role of auditor, comptroller or treasurer. As Washington Director, Ms. Chebinou serves as the primary liaison with Congress, the Administration, federal agencies, and other associations on national issues of governmental finance while representing state governmental positions; providing information to the membership; and assisting in the development of policy. Ms. Chebinou has served as the point person for finance officials on implementation of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and is the current Co-Chair of the National Grants Partnership.
