Darryl W. Mayes was recently promoted as the Mid-Atlantic Field Office director, Division of Cost Allocation (DCA), at the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. He is responsible for managing the day to day operations, developing work plans, and monitoring the reviews, negotiations and approvals of cost allocation plans (state/local and public assistance), facilities and administrative (indirect cost) rates, research patient care rates, fringe benefit rates, and disclosure statements.

Prior to becoming a director, Mr. Mayes served as branch chief of state and local governments. His functions included supervising the negotiations and approvals of various statewide cost allocations plans, public assistance cost plans, and state department indirect cost rates. Mr. Mayes spent eight years as a cost negotiator before he became branch chief.

In 2000, Mr. Mayes briefly left the Division of Cost Allocation, and during his departure he served as an accountant with the Office of Justice Programs, Financial and Monitoring Division, at the U.S. Department of Justice, where he was responsible for monitoring direct and indirect costs charged to Federal grants.

Mr. Mayes began his career with the Defense Contract Audit Agency at the Department of Defense. As an auditor he devoted five years to auditing and reviewing: internal controls; incurred cost audits; pricing proposals; forward pricing proposals; and other audits applicable to cost claimed on federal grants and contracts.

Mr. Mayes received his bachelor's degree in accounting from Virginia State University, and his master's degree in taxation from Southeastern University. Currently, Mr. Mayes is in pursuit of becoming a certified public accountant.

Outside his professional duties, Mr. Mayes enjoys physical fitness and assisting others in accomplishing their health goals. This aspiration has resulted from him serving as a fitness and personal trainer for over two years.
