Edward J. Mazur currently serves as senior advisor for governmental financial management for Cherry, Bekaert & Holland. He has served on both the Governmental Accounting Standards Board and the Federal Accounting Standards Advisory Board. Ed was confirmed by the U.S. Senate in 1991, to be the first controller appointed by the President under the Chief Financial Officers Act of 1990. He served four governors as state comptroller for the commonwealth of Virginia, between 1980 and 1991, and as president of the National Association of State Auditors, Comptrollers, and Treasurers, and the National Association of State Comptrollers. He is a certified public accountant and holds an M.B.A. from Wharton and a B.S. degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Connecticut.
