Cindy Schwimer is the Executive Director for Public Sector Solutions for Oracle Public Sector. Since June 1, 2006, Cindy has provided guidance and direction on enterprise resource planning application solutions for Oracle's current and potential public sector customers.

Cindy draws from more than thirty-one years of Federal government experience in financial management and accounting. She spent more than twenty years at the Department of Justice where she held several leadership positions. She was the Comptroller/CFO for the Office of Justice Programs (OJP). OJP's mission is to improve public safety and administer justice in the fifty states and territories through innovation, partnerships and safer neighborhoods by issuing grants to state and local units of governments. Cindy was a member of the senior executive service ten years before retiring in January 2006. Before joining the Justice Department, she worked for ten years at the Department of Treasury, Financial Management Service.

As the Comptroller for OJP, Cindy led a 200-person organization with fiduciary responsibility to prevent/detect waste, fraud, and abuse for DOJ grants valued at more than \$30 billion. In addition to overseeing accounting, grants management, financial grants monitoring, grantee compliance, internal control reviews, training, and policy development, the Comptroller's Office provided a broad range of financial management support to OJP's program offices and grantees.

Cindy has authored articles on grants financial management in the *Assistance Management Journal*, a publication of the National Grants Management Association and the *FBI Law Enforcement Bulletin*.

She resides in Alexandria, Virginia with her husband Dan and has a son, Michael, who is a professional baseball player in the minor leagues of the Philadelphia Phillies' organization.
