

**KIM WALLIN** is a native Nevadan and is the first CPA to be elected to the office of Nevada state controller in 50 years. She is the first certified management accountant to hold this office.

Kim is currently a member of the Association of Government Accountants' Partnership for Intergovernmental Management and Accountability Steering Committee, treasurer of NASC and is a member of the NASACT Executive Committee. She is also a member of the Institute of Management Accountants' XBRL Standing Committee. In addition she is a member of the IMA, American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, Nevada Society of CPA's, NASACT and AGA.

Kim has been appointed to two workgroups that were formed by an Executive Order. The first one was to address improper payments, and Nevada was one of only three states asked to serve on the workgroup. The second one was President Obama's Federal/State Advisory Committee on Administrative Flexibility, Lower Costs, and Better Results for State, Local, and Tribal Governments. The committee's purpose was to promoting more effective government by reducing unnecessary regulatory and administrative burdens and redirecting resources to services that are essential to achieve better outcomes at lower costs.

In September 2003, *Accounting Today* recognized Wallin as one of the 100 most influential people in accounting in the country. In September 2006 she was named Woman CPA of the Year of the entire country by the American Women's Society of CPA's. In 2011 she received the President's Award from NASACT.

Kim is the former global chair of the Institute of Management Accountants. IMA is the resource for developing, certifying, and connecting the world's best accountants and financial professionals working in business. She served as chair of IMA in 2003-2004 and she served as chair of the Board of Regents of the ICMA. She served for two years on the Ethics Committee of the NSCPA.

Wallin graduated from UNLV with a degree in business administration with a major in accounting.

Kim has been active with local service and volunteer organizations. She has been president of Soroptimist International of Creative Las Vegas and has served as the treasurer for the Opus Dance Ensemble and the Actors Repertory Theatre.
