

The **National Association of State Comptrollers** (NASC) is an affiliate of the National Association of State Auditors, Comptrollers and Treasurers (NASACT). Its members are the chief financial officers of the 50 states, the District of Columbia and the U.S. territories. The main responsibilities of a state comptroller are making disbursements for the state, including payroll, keeping the state’s accounting records, preparing internal and external financial reports, and acting as a financial advisor to other officers in state government.

NASC Annual Conference

NASC holds its annual conference in March each year. The members welcome participation by private sector entities, to whom they often look for experience and expertise in financial management systems. Private sector entities help underwrite the cost of the conference through sponsorships.

Where will the conference be held?

The 2025 conference will be held at the **Embassy Suites by Hilton**, which is centrally located in downtown Denver near shopping, dining and entertainment.
