The NSAA annual conference, held each June, is the association's premiere event. Hotel

The conference will be held at the Beau Rivage. The room rate at the Beau Rivage is \$159 per night (plus applicable taxes) for single or double occupancy. Transportation

The Gulfport-Biloxi International Airport (www.flygpt.com) is about 20-25 minutes from the hotel.

Shuttle service is provided by Gulf Coast Transportation LLC (www.gulfcoasttransportation.com). Our special conference rate is \$15 one way or \$28 roundtrip. Payment can be made to the driver on day of service. Reservations are not required.
